Re: Garbage, Dumpster, Roll-off, and Grease Container Licensing Fees and Permitting Requirements

Dear Sir/Madam:

Attached please find a renewal application for Carting Permit to operate in the Village of Patchogue. Please return with your signed application and fee by December 31st.

The fee for annual registration is \$500 per company.

All companies are responsible for the construction and maintenance of the enclosures which are required by Village Code. Acceptable enclosure material shall be a six-foot chain link fence with privacy slats and locking gates. For all dumpsters and enclosures placed on Village property, applications must follow the same enclosing requirements.

All dumpsters placed on Village property require a certificate of liability insurance in the amount of at least \$1,000,000 naming the Village of Patchogue as additional insured. This certificate must accompany all applications or no permit will be issued. As space on Village property is limited, it is advised that businesses work together to share dumpsters.

It is also the responsibility of your driver to close and relock the enclosure gates after emptying the containers. Failure to do so will constitute a violation of Village Code.

Anytime a new client in the Village of Patchogue is added to your company, the Village must be notified. The same holds true for any cancelled accounts. If no application is submitted and received by December 31st, no permit will be issued.
