

## **Step 9 - Adopt the Plan**

### **9.A Formal Community Process**

On March 14, 2005, a resolution was offered, and officially accepted by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village Of Patchogue, giving the committee, designated Village staff, and the planning consultant, full authority to carry out the steps in the hazards identification, assessment, planning, and mitigation process. On April 24, 2006, a resolution was offered, and officially accepted by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village Of Patchogue, to adopt the draft All hazard Mitigation Plan. The Village Board will adopt the final plan when the draft plan has been reviewed and accepted by the State and Federal reviewers.

The March 14, 2005 resolution reads as follows: (See Volume 2 Attachment 1A)

*Whereas a Floodplain Management and Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee has been formed by the Village to seek community support and provide guidance and citizen input to the Floodplain Management and Hazard Mitigation Plan and to attend project progress meetings and public hearings.*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village of Patchogue that the Floodplain Management and Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee has the full support of the Board and the authority to review the Plan and make recommendations to the Mayor and the Board on the contents of the Plan.

The April 24, 2006 resolution reads as follows: (See Volume 2 Attachment 1B)

*Subject: A public hearing to review and inform the public of the contents of the "draft" All Hazard Plan.*
