

Special Board Meeting – Election Results

March 20, 2008

The Board Meeting of the Board of Trustees met in the Municipal Building, 14 Baker Street, Patchogue, New York on March 20, 2008.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Pontieri with Trustees Crean, Dean, Devlin, Krieger, McGiff, Village Attorney Snead and Village Clerk Seal present. Trustee Hilton was not present.

The flag salute was made by Trustee Krieger.

Mayor Pontieri read the safety message.

Village Clerk Seal stated: The official results for the March 18, 2008, General Election stated: For the office of Mayor from 2008-2012, Paul V. Pontieri, Jr. from Patchogue First Party received a total of 403 votes and has won that seat; Village Trustee from 2008-2012, Stephen J. McGiff from Patchogue First Party received a total of 393 votes to retain his seat; Village Trustee from 2008-2012, Lori B. Devlin from Patchogue First Party received 391 votes to retain her seat; and John A. Krieger from 2008-2012, received 298 votes to retain his seat. On the record, for mayor and one trustee spot somebody wrote in James Burmell; for one trustee spot, it was Ernie Perry; and for one trustee spot it was Sal Minardi.

Upon a motion made by Deputy Mayor McGiff, seconded by Trustee Dean, and unanimously carried, the board accepted the election results as presented above.

Upon a motion made by Trustee Crean, seconded by Trustee Dean, and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
