

REMINDER TO ALL PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF
PATCHOGUE...

Under the code in the Village of Patchogue, the owner or occupant of any real property or premises in the Village is obligated to keep the sidewalk adjacent to or in front of the premises free of snow and ice.

Therefore, residents and business owners are reminded to clear their sidewalks following a snow or ice storm. This will help to provide easy access to pedestrians and ensure their safety.

In addition, snow removed from sidewalks, driveways or curbs should NOT be thrown into the street. It should be piled on the property so that it does not obstruct pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

To assist our volunteer firefighters, it would be greatly appreciated if you would clear snow around any fire hydrant in front of or next to your premises. This would provide easier access should the need arise.

SNOW EMERGENCY

PATCHOGUE VILLAGE CODE 62-11

_VEHICLE PARKING IS PROHIBITED ON ALL STREETS DURING A SNOW STORM EMERGENCY, WITH SNOW ACCUMULATION OF TWO (2) INCHES OR MORE. ALL VEHICLES IN VIOLATION WILL BE TOWED.
